



PAYMENT OF FEE

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Students are required to wear school uniform as given below:

- a) Summer: Grey terry cot shorts for boys upto class V (as per school colour). Trousers of the same material for other classes (boys).
- b) Winter: Grey terry cot trousers for boys upto class XII (as per school colour).
- c) Summer and Winter: Grey terry cot pleated skirts for girls (as per school colour)
- a) White terry cat shirts half sleeves with school insignia and school monogram for summer and full sleeves for winter. (for boys)
- b) White terry cot blouses half sleeve with school insignia and school managram for summer and full sleeve for winter.
- · Bloomers (compulsory) for girls of all classes.
- . Grey socks with 3 white stripes on the top.
- a) Shoes- Black laced Oxford pattern for boys.
- b) Shoes- Black buckled strap for girls.
- · Maroon Blazers (single breast) with brass button bearing school insignia and school monogram are compulsory for winter. Maroon full sleeved pullover of the approved pattern for LKG
- · Maroon sleeveless pullovers (plain without designs) matching the colour of the school blazer may be worn extra if it is very cold.
- Metal badges as per House colours to be worn on left lapel of the school blazer (classes VI and above)
